Funding Opportunities for Trust Members

Bournemouth 2026 Trust holds a small grant fund which it can allocate to members of the Trust for projects in priority areas. These grants are considered through a specific process. Eligible projects must address one of the four Trust priorities which are currently Boscombe or West Howe Regeneration, Turnaround Families Matter or Young People Realising Their Potential. If a strategic assessment has addressed issues in particular, the project should deal with issues raised in that assessment.

Successful projects will have to be initially approved by the relevant Partnership Board (where there is one) and address the golden threads which are integral to the activities of Bournemouth 2026 Trust. The golden threads include: community influencing decisions; within the principles of the Earth Charter; focus on prevention & early intervention; and reduce inequality.

Eligible projects must also have clear measurable outcomes and leave a positive legacy. It is important that the project also results in positive PR for the Trust.
