Bournemouth's Community Vision 2026

1. Introduction

The Strategic Leadership Forum agreed at its first meeting on 12th December 2012 that part of its role would be to oversee the updating of the Community Plan/Sustainable Community Strategy. Bournemouth 2026 Trust was asked to commission a workshop early in 2013 to begin the updating process and to bring it back to Strategic Leadership Forum after the plan had been discussed at the Trust's AGM. It was suggested at the June meeting that the SCS could be used as the basis for a joined up approach to measuring Social Value. This meeting is the first opportunity following the Trust's AGM to present the updated Sustainable Community Strategy which is entitled Bournemouth's Community Vision 2026.

2. Consultation and involvement

The Trust arranged and facilitated a total of 5 workshops at Bournemouth Learning Centre in Ensbury Park, Wellspring Centre in Boscombe and Kinson Community Centre, consulting on the priority areas for Bournemouth's Community Vision. Many organisations and individuals participated in these events which laid the foundation for the updated strategy. In addition, a first draft of Bournemouth's Community Vision was discussed during group work at the Trusts AGM in September, and a 6 week online consultation was launched through a web survey. Since then the draft has been shared with the Police & Crime Commissioners office, a number of Council officers and directors, the Bournemouth Chamber of Trade & Commerce and Dorset Clinical Commissioning Group for comments and input.

Links were made with key strategic documents eg Health & Wellbeing Strategy, the Bournemouth Local Plan: Core Strategy, Bournemouth Housing Strategy, the NHS Dorset Clinical Commissioning Group strategy 2013-18 and many other strategies and research documents were used as sources of evidence for the Vision document.

3. Next steps

Following discussion at the Strategic Leadership Forum the draft Vision will be submitted to Bournemouth Council to be put through its processes. It is intended that the document will be eventually adopted by Bournemouth Council before publication next year.

Whilst this is in process, it is intended to commission a local artist and writer to produce a poster version which will be a summarised version of the Vision, produced

imaginatively and in a more user friendly format. The complete document will only be produced in low numbers in hard copy but will be available on-line as a resource.

It is intended to launch the agreed vision at a Bournemouth 2026 Trust event early in 2014.

4. Recommendation

The Strategic Leadership Forum is asked to endorse Bournemouth's Community Vision and recommend it to the Council.
